

2012-2013 Distinguished Service Award Recipient Sam Ruljancich

Sam was born in Seattle, and grew up in a south Seattle neighborhood. There he was part of a close -knit Croatian community where many were part of his extended family of grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins. 
