Image Database



Your submission to a competition does two things

- It uploads a copy to your personal *Image Library*
- It connects the competition to the copy

Other uses of that image connect to the library copy

Thus only one copy of an image exists in the database

When you enter end-of-year, all your images will be available from the library

What's a Competition?

It's a collection of images with a theme, maximum entries per person and optional judging Projected image night has 3 or 4 competitions: Open, Nature, Creative and Assignment An event like small groups may have just one unjudged "competition"

What's a *Gallery*?

A set of images drawn from competitions or the image library, like Best of April Projected images or your own gallery from a field trip Can be displayed as a Slideshow, a Grid or Individually full screen

The screens for image submission have a lot of options and words of explanation, so they look complicated However there are just a few buttons to push and two entries to type

Submitting a couple images is fast and straightforward in practice



Changes to be aware of:

- (1) You no longer need to use any special file naming. This submission process knows who you are and the image category. You type in the displayed title after the image is uploaded.
- (2) We recommend you continue to size your images to 1920 max width and 1200 max height This fills the projector or typical computer screen to show at the best quality.

 The site will downsize larger images to fit the target, but will not upsize smaller ones.





Use the "Select" button below to select one or more files to upload. On most browsers you can also drag and drop files onto the Select button. Use the "Select" button to add additional files. The upload process will start with each file as soon as you use the Select button. When all the files have been uploaded, as indicated by the green dot by each file name, click the "Save Images" button below.

Please only upload only your own images. You will become the author of any images you upload and your images will be marked with your copyright. Avoid uploading auplicate images. Instead, reference your existing image in your Image Library.

After your images are uploaded into your library, references to those images will be automatically entered into your Competition.


How to Submit Projected Images - 6

Almost there!

The *title* will probably start with your file name in it Change to whatever you like up to 65 characters —

The optional *Authors ID* can be left blank, or perhaps set to the camera image number

Click the Save button which finally sends the image to your Image Library and adds it to the competition

From the Competitions menu select Vote for People's Choice


Select a competition available for people's choice

Mark your choice or choices with checkmarks


You can switch between full screen and thumbnails any time

My Account -- Image Library


Add images to Library without going through a competition (SPS does not use sequences)

Select the images in the list by whether in a competition, award, score, etc

Edit title or Delete image

Click the small triangle to show or hide the where used information

If you make edits to titles or delete images be sure to click the Save button



My Account -- Image History

Lists only images that have been entered into a competition

Click to reload list

Click to filter the images by award, score, etc

Turns image thumbnails on/off

Reminder: Event Date is the final results date not the meeting date. For example Competition 21-08-03 Open was the meeting date and the results were posted 8/26



Either go to My Account, My Galleries or use this button on the gallery list pages




Galleries for competitions are created and loaded by the web site editors







How to Judge - 1


Select Judge menu and Judging Queue for Website Judging

Set the date range to include when the results are to be posted, generally between the meeting date and a couple weeks afterwards

Remember the "Competition Date" is when the results will be made available -- not the meeting date

Select one of the competitions you are to judge

Only competitions that are open for judging and you are one of the assigned judges will appear To experiment with judging skip down to slide 35

How to Judge - 1


An important reminder

Select the "All Images" Competition Level if images are not visible

Use this any time to change the thumbnail sorting

"My scores ... completed" must be <u>un</u>checked to start When you are finished judging please check it

Scroll down to show the image thumbnails



Very important Button


Click after a set of changes or before switching to full screen

Drag and drop a title to change the thumbnail order

Tip: Ranking images 1st may be easiest before setting scores

How to Judge - 3

Ignore I button: Projected Dir sets Ignore C button: SPS does not use



Single-click an image to go full screen
See next slide

Type in score number and <u>Enter key</u> Leave the score 0 if it's you<u>r image</u>

See the SPS website Judge, Scoring Guide for point level interpretation

How to Judge - 4



On the website check the *Judge, Scoring Guide* for point number interpretation

- Type the score in the box
- SPS does not use Critique or Disqualify
- < Prior and Next > buttons step images
- Exit button returns to the thumbnails after saving any score changes

Judging Status

My scores, rankings, and critiques have been completed for all Competition Levels

When you are finished judging be sure to mark this checkbox in the previous thumbnail screen to inform the competition manager

Practicing with the Judging Example

There is a sample competition which allows judges to experiment.

A competition director must add you to the practice competition list of judges first.

Login to www.seattlephotographic.com Select the menu Judge, Judging Queue

Set the Earliest and Latest dates to include 12/31/21 Click Refresh Competition List button

Do not check this box

Select the Judging example from the list
